

Barcelona hosts the Parabere Forum 2017 on 5th and 6th March



On 5th and 6th March, the Catalan capital will be hosting the third [Parabere Forum](#), a non-profit international platform featuring the views of women from around the world who are experts on issues regarding food, nutrition and agriculture.

The [Parabere Forum 2017](#) will focus on the sustainability of the food and farming industry and the food and wine sector in our working lives and on the planet.

During the two-day event, there will be lectures and panel discussions featuring 300 eminent opinion-leaders from around the world. The sessions will address all kinds of issues, from the role of chefs in the 21st century to the ways quality can become a tool to improve sustainability and the interaction between restaurants and producers. There will also be a debate about women chefs and a screening of the documentary *The Goddesses of Food*, about the women associated with gastronomy and food who are changing the world.

Catalonia will be represented by the chef Fina Puigdeval, from the restaurant Les Cols; Nani Moré, from the Catalan Organic Consumers' Association; and Sara Pérez, from the Mas Martinet winery, among others. The congress will be closed by the chef and co-owner of the Celler de Can Roca, Joan Roca. He will be giving a talk entitled "Cooking with awareness".
